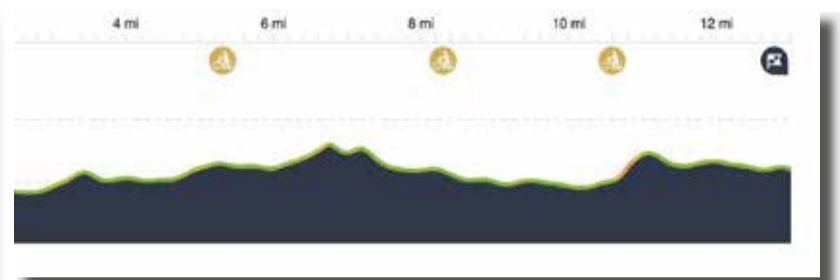
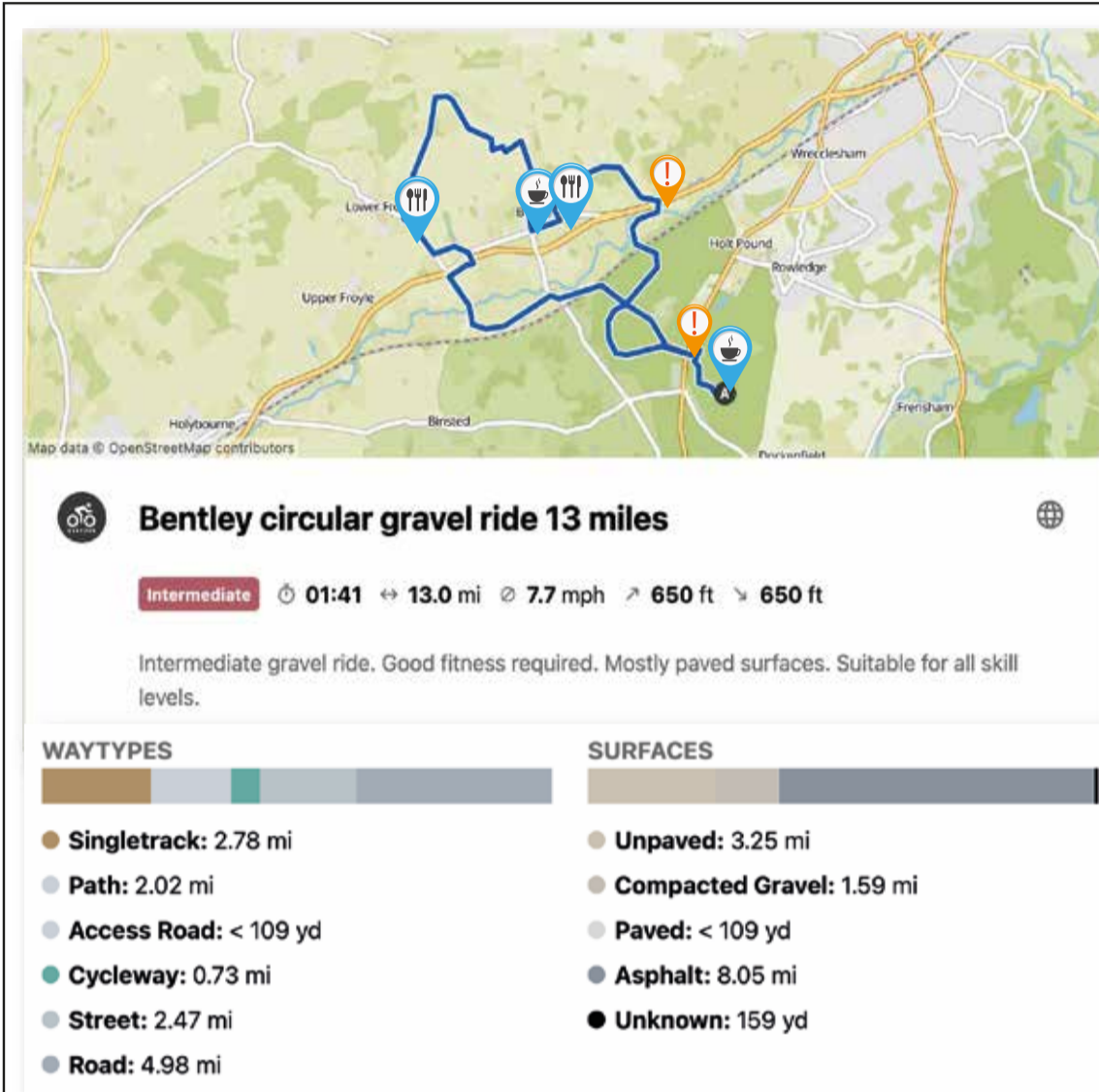


# BENTLEY CIRCULAR GRAVEL/ROAD 13MILES



This undulating 13 mile route is ideal for a leisurely 2-3 hour ride, excluding stops. It skirts the forest before crossing the road (take care), taking forest tracks to Bentley Station from where a wide scenic loop climbs to a high point before dropping down to Lower Froyle and Bentley station on quiet roads before returning via the forest. There are great pub choices along the way with the Star Inn at Bentley and the Anchor Inn on the return journey at Lower Froyle.
