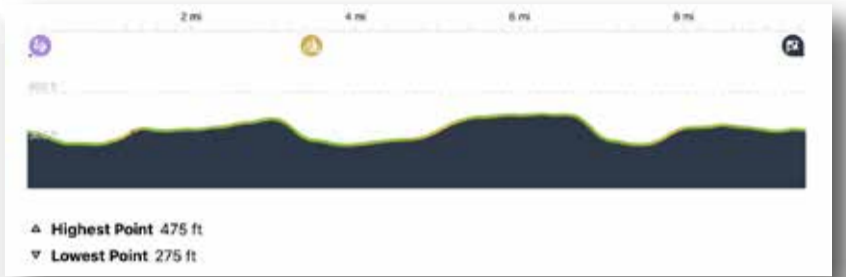


BLACKNEST CIRCULAR GRAVEL/ROAD 9.5 MILES



A 9.5 mile route that is ideal for a leisurely 2-3 hour ride, with a relaxed pub stop. Combining forest tracks, gravel paths and country lanes, the route takes you on a relaxed ride around the outskirts of Alice Holt using the forest tracks of the Shipwrights way to Bentley Station and on to some scenic small lanes to explore the area. There are pub stops at the Binsted Inn or the Jolly Farmer Pub in Blacknest before heading up the hill and back in to Alice Holt to complete the tour.
